Admission Requirements:

- Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD), or equivalent, including the following required courses:
 - English - any Grade 12 (C) or (U), or equivalent
 - Mathematics - any Grade 12 (C) or (U), or equivalent
 - Biology - Grade 11 (C) or (U) or Grade 12 (U) **OR** Chemistry - Grade 11 (U) or Grade 12 (C) or (U)
- Submission of a portfolio, as follows:
 - Cover letter - outlining your career objectives and reasons for your interest in the Brewmaster and Brewery Operations Management program
 - Current resume detailing education, work experience, activities, interests, etc.
 - Personal statement explaining why you would be an ideal candidate for this program, keeping in mind that this program combines classroom, applied learning and fieldwork
 - Additional Documentation – Please include any reference letters or other documents that you believe will assist your placement into the program
- Student is required to be 19 years of age or older by the start of classes
