

PROOF OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY EXEMPTIONS

The following applicants are exempt from submitting [English language proficiency](#) scores:

- 1** International students who completed a minimum of two years of full-time secondary (int eh final two years of secondary study) or one full-time postsecondary or higher education in a country where English is an official or the only language of common usage (check below if your country is listed on our English as a Second Language (ESL) exemption list).
- 2** International students who obtain an International Baccalaureate in English from one of the International Schools' members of the Council of International Schools (www.cois.org).
- 3** Graduation from Niagara College's English for Academic Preparation program offering conditional admission. All other students must submit their valid English Language Proficiency Test scores to International Admissions. Only tests taken in the last 2 years are considered valid. **Please note exemptions do not apply to NC's [Teaching English as a Second Language \(TESL\)](#) and [Pharmacy Technician](#) programs which will still require proof of English language proficiency for admission.*
