Thank you for your interest in the Public Relations Graduate Certificate program. The eight-month, full-time Public Relations graduate certificate program provides a focused curriculum on public relations principles, practices and their application for entry-level public relations practitioners.

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelor’s Degree in any field of study
- **OR** Ontario College Diploma (or equivalent) in a related area of study (as determined by the college) including: Business and Management Studies, Communications, Journalism, and Broadcasting
- **OR** Applicants with a College Diploma who have studied outside these fields of study **OR** those who have an acceptable combination of related work experience and post-secondary education (as determined by Niagara College), please submit a portfolio that includes:
 - A one-page letter indicating why you feel you would be successful in the PR program and what public relations experience you have already, and
 - A one-page resume that includes your educational and work background, including related public relations volunteer experiences. Please also provide your current email address.
- Proof of English proficiency
