- Bachelor’s Degree in Behavioural Science, Child Studies, Education, Psychology, Speech and Language Sciences, Social Work or Sociology, **OR**
- For applicants with a Bachelor’s Degree or a College Diploma who have studied outside of these fields of study, please submit a portfolio that includes:
 - A one-page cover letter indicating why you feel you would be successful in the Autism and Behavioural Science program and what experience you have already
 - A resume that includes your educational and work background with a current email address
- Proof of English proficiency
