

2025 Spousal Program Terms and Conditions

- Available to spouses of international students originally from Latin America and the Caribbean, enrolled full-time at Niagara College in an academic program starting in Spring 2025, Fall 2025 or Winter 2026.
- The student's spouse must be enrolled in a program that Niagara College identifies as ineligible for a Post-Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) at the time of application or in Niagara College's English for Academic Preparation program.
- This program is exclusively available to new students where both the international student and their spouse apply together at the same time. Students already enrolled at Niagara College are not eligible to bring their spouse under this program.
- The spouse receiving the scholarship must be enrolled in a program with a duration equal to or shorter than that of the program undertaken by the student not receiving the scholarship.
- The designated scholarship application, along with a marriage certificate, must be submitted to Niagara College within two weeks of the spouse's application to the college.
- Both students must pay the required fees by the specified date on their most recent invoice to secure their seats.
- Contingent on both students maintaining good academic standing, successful scholarship applicants will receive a scholarship that will be applied towards the spouse's program as per the schedule below:
 - \$7,000 CAD scholarship towards Term 1 of their academic program, and
 - an additional \$7,000 CAD each subsequent term of the spouse's program.
- Each student must meet the respective academic and English language admission requirements to qualify.
- This scholarship cannot be combined with other Niagara College entrance scholarships. However, the spouse not receiving the Spousal Program Scholarship may apply for other entrance scholarship opportunities.
- The scholarship will be automatically applied to eligible student accounts and could be viewed through the students' [MyNC Student Portal](#) after the first 45 days of term/program start has passed.
 - If the student qualifies for an extended withdrawal date, the scholarship will only be awarded after the amended withdrawal date.
